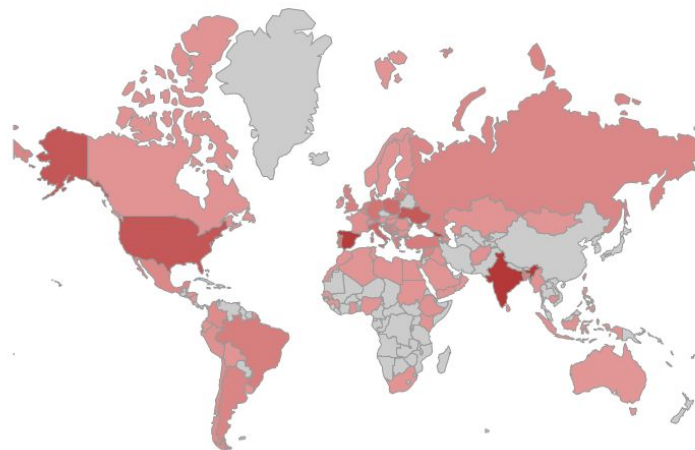

Countries in shades of red represent the amount of disinformation that has been identified and debunked by national fact-checkers in each country.

When you click on a piece of disinformation, countries in which that hoax has circulated highlight in blue and you can access each country's debunking in its language below

When you click on a country you can see which disinformation has been identified and fact-checked in that country and access the national fact-checker's articles in their language.

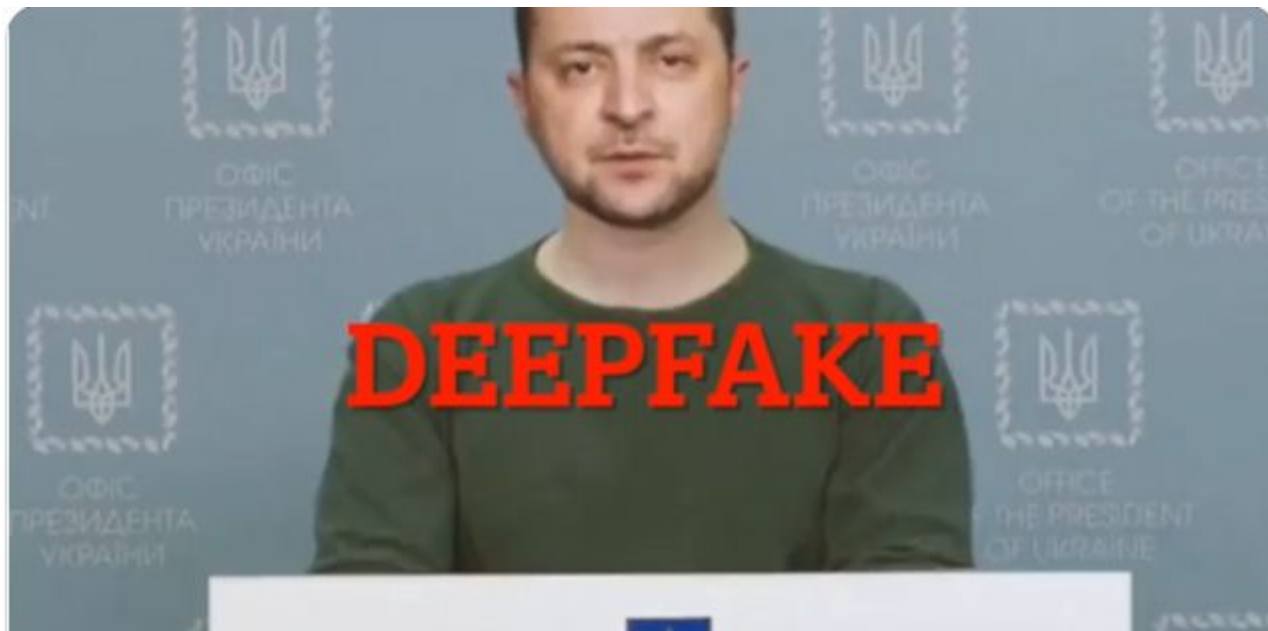
Fake tweets

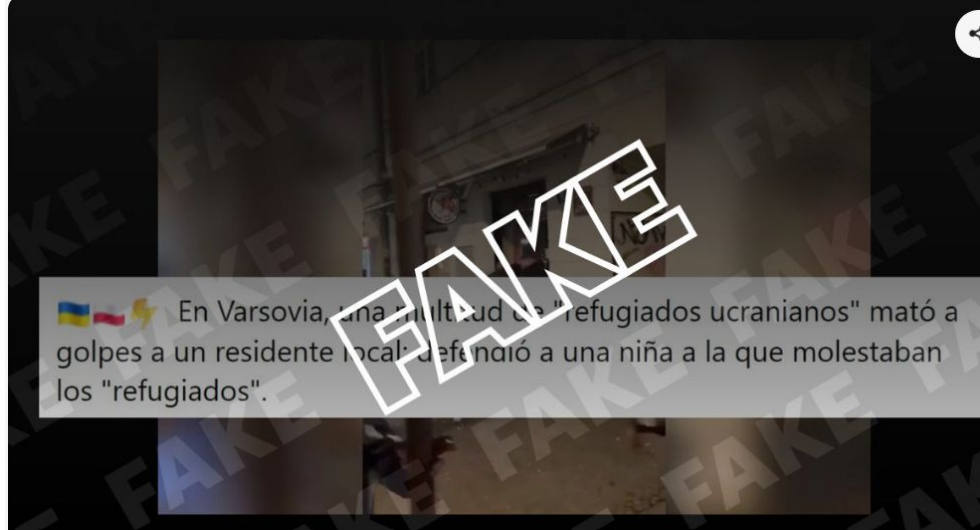

Common narratives of misinformation and disinformation around the war in Ukrania

- Pictures and videos taken out of context about bombings or explosions
- Disinformation portraying Zelenski as a cocaine addict and Nazi
- Other hoaxes have cast doubt on the existence of casualties after some of the attacks, claiming they were actors.
- Alleged war heroes of Ukraine who never existed, such as "the ghost of Kiev" or the supposed pilot Natasha Perakov
- Disinformation and misinformation about Ukrainian refugees (they are portrayed as violent or dangerous)

Disinformation and misinformation about Ukrainian refugees



It is not true that the perpetrators of a deadly assault filmed in Warsaw, Poland, are Ukrainian refugees.



The daily 'Bild' has not reported that Ukrainian refugees set a fire in Germany by burning a Russian flag.
